### Whites

- Elvaro Sauvignon Blanc, Chile 2009** € 23.00 €6.25  
Wine of green-yellow colour with fresh aromas of citrus and tropical fruits. It has a good body and persistence.
- Libertas Chardonnay Western Cape, South Africa 2009** € 24.00 €6.50  
A crisp and fruity wine. Renowned as a quality estate from the heart of South Africa
- Cape Grace Chenin Blanc, South Africa 2008** € 24.50 €6.95  
This well balanced Chenin Blanc shows the fresh and fruity style typical of the Rawsonville region. The nose is complex with tropical notes of pineapple and guava. The palate is full and rich with pronounced apricot and peach flavours. The touch of oak contributes to the complexity with a hint of spice. The finish is crisp yet lingering.
- Bilyara Wolf Blass Chardonnay, Australia 2008** € 26.00 €7.25  
Attractive fresh tropical fruit aroma of ripe limes and pineapples. Crisp ripe juicy tropical fruit on taste.
- Santa Digna Reserva Sauvignon Blanc Miguel Torres, Chile 2008** € 27.50 €7.95  
Crisp and fragrant with an intense nose of tropical fruits and freshly cut green apple, plus the slightest hint of fennel. On the palate it is well balanced with a long elegant finish.

### Rosé

- Santa Digna Cabernet Sauvignon Rosé Miguel Torres, Chile 2008** € 27.50 €7.95  
Fragrant and floral, with a temptingly fruity sensuality. On the palate the wine is voluptuous, with a silky texture and the sort of fresh, fruity body (blackcurrant, cranberry, redcurrant) that only Pacific Cabernet Sauvignon roses can offer.
- Fetzer Valley Oaks Syrah Rosé, USA 2005** € 31.00 €8.50  
This Californian fruity wine is testament to one of the world's fastest rising winemakers

## White Wine Selection

### France

- Belleruche Blanc, Cotes du Rhone Chapoutier 2008** € 29.00  
Made predominately from white Grenache grapes, this is dry wine with good ripe flavours.
- Macon Lugny Jaffin 2006** € 36.00  
The colour is pale gold with delicate hints of green. Bouquet is subtle, yet vibrant, aromas of flowers and herbs, lemon and mint, honeysuckle. The palate is well balanced with a lively style. Full, smooth and with good acidity levels. Floral and herbal flavours prevail.
- Riesling, FE Hugel et Fils 2007** € 41.00  
Made from the classic Riesling grape, this lively refreshing dry wine is flavoursome with an elegant finish.
- Chablis AC, J Moreau et Fils 2007** € 45.00  
Moreau make their Chablis wines unoaked to maintain the natural freshness of Chardonnay. Refreshingly dry it has typical citrus and lemon flavours on the palate and finish.
- Sancerre, Jean Max Roger 2007** € 45.00  
Beautiful aromatic bouquet, with fresh appetising fruit, full and ripe with zippy acidity.
- Meursault, Louis Jadot 2006** € 79.00  
Jadot ages its Meursault for 15 months in wood. The wine is ripe, rich, and full bodied with distinctive hazelnut flavours on the finish.
- Hermitage Blanc Le Mea, Chapoutier 2001** € 95.00  
The youthful flavours of pear, peach and honeysuckle are now complemented by a nutty mature character, and a fine minerality. Still fresh in the mouth, with a long finish.
- Puligny Montrachet 1er Cru Clos de la Garenne, Louis Jadot 2001** € 127.00  
Made only in small quantities this wine is full bodied and rich with a lot of concentrated aromas of honey, white fruit and flowers. From a single estate – an intense concentrated wine with excellent ageing capacity.

### Italy

- Pinot Grigio delle Venezia, Vaja 2008** € 31.00  
A very pleasant and characteristic bouquet, this wine is soft, dry and relatively full flavoured with a clean, fresh finish
- Masi, Masianco Pinot Grigio & Verduzzo 2007** € 34.00  
Made predominately from the Pinot Grigio grape this is a modern white wine with character and style. The palate is full, rich and dry with a delicate vanilla note on the finish.

### Australia

- Penfold's Private Release Chardonnay 2007** € 28.00  
One of a unique selection from the Penfold's stable.
- Rutherglen Estate Voignier 2007** € 32.00  
Strong honeysuckle, apricot, lychee and tropical fruit sensations that are complemented by creamy vanilla and coconut undertones. This Voignier is fresh and crisp and suites all palates.

### New Zealand

- Lake Chalice Sauvignon Blanc 2008** € 38.00  
A crisp, medium bodied, dry wine bursting with classical varietal flavours of passion fruit, blackcurrant and gooseberry. Mouth watering acidity is balanced by a long, elegant, mineral finish.
- Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc/Marborough 2008** € 61.00

## France

- Belleruche Rouge, Côtes du Rhône, Chapoutier 2007** € 29.00  
*Made predominately from the Grenache grape, this is well balanced with good fruit flavours.*
- Fleurie Jaffin 2006** € 36.00  
*Beautifully smooth, bundles of fruity aromas, a silky wine. A classic gamey grape from one of the top houses in Beaujolais*
- Reserve Mouton Cadet, St Emilion, Baron Philippe de Rothschild 2006** € 42.00  
*A well developed bouquet with lots of weighty fruit, spice and peppery overtones. This is a full, velvety and sensuous wine.*
- Fleurie Domaine de Poncereau, Louis Jadot 2007** € 46.00  
*This single estate Fleurie made from the Gamay grape has typical raspberry fruit flavours with a medium body and good finish*
- Chateauneuf de Pape, La Bernardine 2006** € 54.00  
*Rich, powerful, full bodied generous wine with excellent finish with just a hint of spice.*
- Chateau Lanessan, Cru Bourgeois Exceptionnel St Laurant 2000** € 79.00  
*Lovely nose of dark juicy fruit, with touches of toasted walnuts, and cake spice. Very nice ripe cassis flavour, excellent balance, and long smooth finish.*
- Chateau Lagrange, St Julien 3eme Cru Classe 2000** € 95.00  
*Fat and rich on the nose, with dense black cherry fruit and oak, with a burnt, toasty edge. There is a hint of fat, rich opulence and buttery fruit on the palate.*
- Clos Vougeot Grand Cru, Domaine Louis Jadot 2001** € 115.00  
*A wine now approaching its prime, this wine is full and rich, and robust by Burgundy standards. The time in bottle will have added immensely to its character, with red and black fruit, savoury tones and a mineral finish. True Grand Cru quality.*

## Spain

- Marquis de Riscal, Tempranillo 2006** €29.50  
*A spicy bouquet leads to a glorious smooth palate with ripe, juicy blackcurrant fruit flavours and well integrated oak,*
- Crianza Rioja Ibericos 2006** € 36.00  
*Deep red cherry colour. On the nose, it reveals notes of forest fruits balanced with dark roasted notes from the wood. On the palate it has smooth tannins and fine fruity sensations.*
- Baron de Chirel Reserva, Marques de Riscal 2003** € 127.00  
*Riscal's finest wine, Baron de Chirel is a unique wine in Rioja as it has a very high proportion of Cabernet Sauvignon in the blend. It has twice been rated as Spain's finest red, a tribute to their winemaking skills. It is fast becoming a collector's item and has a wonderful complex bouquet with layers of flavours.*

## Italy

- Masi Campofiorin 2006** € 34.00  
*This unique wine is made by the "Ripasso" method which semi dries the grapes and then re-ferments. This results in a classic wine that is rich, full-bodied, round and velvety with an ageing capacity of 15 years.*
- Antinori Tignanello 2005** € 148.00  
*This was the first of the Super Tuscan wines, made from Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon grapes. Internationally acclaimed, it is a rich, powerful, flavoursome wine packed with fruit and wonderful undertones of oak flavours. A collector's item.*

## Chile

- Carmen Reserva Pinot Noir 2006** € 42.00  
*Another example as to why Chile is now the premium wine region in the world.*

## South Africa

- Graham Beck Shiraz 2004** €35.00  
*Ripe mulberry, blueberry and white pepper on the nose with layers of ripe berry fruit and spiciness. Big structured wine with juicy mid palate and elegant but firm tannins on the finish.*

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## Australia

**Penfold's Private Release Shiraz/Cabernet 2008** € 28.00

One of a unique selection from the Penfold's stable.

**Voignier Shiraz Rutherglen Estate 2006** € 32.00

This wine has a rich red colour with a violet hue, aromas of blackberry and spicy pepper with complex, lingering ripe fruit characters and hints of chocolate, liquorice and vanilla oak characters. This wine is rich, mouth filling and enduring.

## New Zealand

**Saint Clair Pinot Noir Marlborough 2007** € 38.00

A luscious, medium bodied Pinot Noir with a round, soft, full palate, well balanced acidity and supple tannins. Blackberry and boysenberry flavours dominate the palate and are supported by hints of raspberry and redcurrant. This wine has rich savoury notes and a lingering finish.

## Argentina

**Kaikén, Reserve Malbec 2007** € 31.00

The nose shows notes of ripe fruit and traces of butterscotch. The palate displays intensity and strong fruit flavours. The wood balances it perfectly to show an example of the Mendoza region.

**Teresa Rizzi Prosecco Frizzante 'Spago'** € 29.50

A fresh, pleasantly soft, lively, clean, dry and harmonious, Prosecco. Pale yellow in colour, fine bubbles, and a fruity intense bouquet.

**Sparkling Green Point Chardonnay N.V.** € 38.50

Flavours of white peach honey and roasted nuts blend harmoniously in this complex but beautiful wine.

**Moet et Chandon Brut N.V.** € 79.00

Elegant, rich buttery aroma with hints of toasted almonds. Everyone's first choice.

**Veuve Cliquot Yellow Label N.V.** €105.00

**Moet et Chandon Rosé N.V.** €119.00

Attractive pink with an alluring flavour of limes and slightly spicy blossom and blackcurrants

The palate is a blast of pure apricot fruit

**Muscadet de Sevre-et-Maine Sur Lie Chateau de la Cassemichere, 2007** € 18.00

This Chateau produces top quality Muscadet which has excellent freshness, good levels of fruit

**Jafflin, Macon Lugny, 2006** € 19.50

The colour is pale gold with delicate hints of green. Bouquet is subtle, yet vibrant, aromas of flowers and herbs, lemon and mint, honeysuckle. The palate is well balanced with a lively style. Full, smooth and with good acidity levels. Floral and herbal flavours prevail.
